TRYOUT OVERVIEW

Edmonton Ice AA Tryouts begin August 22 , 2026

- All players who plan to tryout for a AA team must register for Elite AA Tryouts.
 - You must be an Edmonton resident to try out for an Edmonton AA team for the first tryout or have special permission.
 - Register **only** for the AA tryouts. **Do not** register for the EFHA Tiered Registration, until you know the outcome of the tryouts for your player.

Players who wish to tryout from another Edmonton Organization:

- If you have not registered with EFHA previously, please fill out [Intent to Register with EFHA](#) form prior to registration. You will not be able to register until the player's HCR file has been transferred/shared.
 - Transfers of HCR files can only take place on or after June 1, 2026

Players previously registered with EFHA, and your home organization remains

EFHA:

- Please register for the AA tryout under your correct age group.
- You will **only** register for the tryouts at this point (Not tiered registration).
- After tryouts, depending on where the player ends up, you will then go in and register for the corresponding season registration.

Players who are looking to tryout with an EFHA AA team but do not reside within Edmonton (or the previous Leduc boundaries):

Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) and Respect in Sport (RIS)

- Please ensure that the player has an HCR number. This is found in your [Spordle Account](#)
- At least one parent/guardian has a current Respect in Sport Parent course as this will be required when registering for the season with a AA team or EFHA Tiered Team.
- If RIS is not current, you will need to take the New program which will be replacing the RIS program, The Shift Forward.

THE SHIFT FORWARD PROGRAM

Your Hockey information is hosted within Spordle. If you have been registered in hockey before as a player, coach, manager, trainer, and/or official, here is how to find your HOCKEY Canada ID#:

- Step 1: Log in to your Spordle account.
- Step 2: Click the profile icon in the top right corner.
- Step 3: On the left side of the page, select "**Members**"
- Step 4: Select your participant from the icons labelled with player initials.
- Step 5: Click "**View Profile**"
- The Hockey Canada ID number is located directly below the player's name (8-14 digits long).
